Concerning financial support to third parties, mentioned at pag 11 of guidelines: is the cash transfer for beneficiaries included in the financial support to third parties? if yes, who can be considered as a third party: the beneficiaries themselves or a payment agency?	The 3rd payment in this case could be a payment agent or any person that supports you in meeting the objective of the Call which will have to defined in the grant contract, if the applicant is successful
Could you please confirm that for this Call for Proposal we do not need to submit any document on PROSPECT? Moreover, could you please confirm there is no need to register co-applicants on PADOR?	There is no document to be submitted on PROSPECT and no registration on PADOR by applicants. All applications MUST be delivered as stated in page 17 (2.2.2) as per the guidelines

<p>Can my organisation participate in a CfP by the EU?</p>	<p>Please refer to 2.1.1 in order to be eligible for a grant the entity must be: “be established in a Member State of the European Union or in The Gambia. Also refer to the foot note on page 6 of the guidelines.</p>
<p>Concerning the cash transfer amount to beneficiaries, can you confirm that the total amount of the expected transfer (e.g. 450 dalasi * 1000 beneficiaries * 10 months = 4500000 dalasi) will be part of the eligible cost of the action? If yes, is there a minimum quote of the budget to be dedicated to? Otherwise, from which sources this amount could come from?</p>	<p>The amounts mentioned in the guidelines for the cash transfers would be part of the eligible cost. Please all the Lots see page 4 of the guidelines. Also, refer to the foot note on page 4.</p>
<p>Considering the cash transfer activities and selection criteria defined by the applicants, do you say that 100% of beneficiaries in the target area should be covered or, because of the resources available (budget amount limits), a pilot covering x% quote < than 100%, can be considered as an eligible target too?</p>	<p>Please refer to the lots (page 4) of the guidelines also a reasonable number of beneficiaries in the areas could be considered factoring the resources available too.</p>
